2. **NSCC Study Requirements:** All NSCC cadets are reminded that they are required to submit at least two completed BMR or Seaman Assignments between each drill. This is a requirement for promotion, participation in any advanced training, and retention in the program. In addition, remember that you cannot be promoted without a qualified advanced training to match your study guides. Too many cadets remain way behind in meeting these requirements.
3. **ID Card Expiration (April / May 2012):** Renewals need to be requested from LTJG Wagner now. This is a requirement for participating in drill and any other NSCC or NLCC training. NOTE: You cannot attend any training without a current ID card.

4. **Recruiting:** All hands are tasked to recruit new cadets and staff for the unit. Remember the recruiting incentive: recruiting three cadets will earn a FREE training for you.
